



Cedar City Flag Redesign Project 2023- A Youth Council Project

Wednesday, October 18, 2023

Timeline: On August 14th, the Cedar City Flag Redesign Project was officially launched through social media, newspaper, local media, posters, and through the local schools. Rules, design guidelines, and criteria were outlined on the city website (see below) with submissions due by September 15th to the Cedar City Youth Council email. A judging panel of community leaders were selected to narrow down the 60 submissions between October 6th and October 16th. Webpage: www.cedarcity.org/flag

Rules:

- Only one design submission per person; Open to all ages
- Must follow guidelines and criteria
- If a flag design is chosen, the artist understands the copyright will belong to the city
- Artist understands their design may be altered by a professional graphic designer, if needed.
- The committee has the right to divide prize money if two designs are top contenders.

Design Guidelines & Criteria:

- Must include "Cedar City", can also include "Festival City, USA" in the design
- Must only use approved city colors
- Must symbolize unique characteristics and the timeless nature of Cedar City with simple shapes (no photos/images)
- Cannot include non-city logos in the design
- Design must include an attached description of the symbolism & thought behind the flag
